The health and safety of our visitors are of paramount importance to Oolite Arts. Oolite is closely monitoring the latest developments regarding novel coronavirus (“SARS-CoV-2,” which causes the disease known as “COVID-19”) to ensure that we are following appropriate recommendations from health authorities and to proactively implement measures to ensure a safe workplace. Below is a list of precautions that Oolite is taking to ensure a safe place for everyone.

- Any person who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or has been in close contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days will not be permitted access to Oolite.
- All visitors must stay away from the facility if they are sick (e.g., experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 [fever, cough, fatigue, or shortness of breath]).
- All visitors are required to take their own temperature before arriving at Oolite’s facility. If the visitor has a fever (100.4 Fahrenheit or higher), they will not be permitted access to Oolite.
- All visitors are required to wear a mask or other cloth material that covers the mouth and nose while on the property.
- Social distancing is required. This is accomplished by avoiding large gatherings and maintaining distance (approximately 6 feet) from others.
- Both the elevator and restrooms have a maximum occupancy of one (1).
- One stairwell is designated for traffic flowing upwards while the other stairwell is designated for traffic flowing downwards.
- Multiple hand sanitizing stations and containers of disinfectant wipes on each floor are available.
- Signage regarding prevention methods have been posted throughout the facility.
